FOOTBALL CLUB TRAINING KIT POLICY

Background

In line with our recent investments in coaching qualifications, equipment, and overall professionalisation of the club, South Park Football Club has decided to introduce a standardised training kit for South Park Juniors.

This decision was made following a meeting with coaches and managers, who agreed that this would be a positive move for the club.

Training Kit Details

The training kit will consist of:

- Jumper/quarter zip
- T-shirt
- Shorts

Pricing

The club has secured a significant discount for the entire club's first order, which will be reflected in the subscription costs.

- Junior size: £44.32 (Discounted to £36 for initial order)
- Senior size: £53.18 (Discounted to £43 for initial order)

Implementation

The club is committed to making future kits as affordable as possible and will always seek further discounts or special offers. As well as implementing a South Park Swap Shop where old or unused training kits can be donated to and used by others within the club.

- The training kit will be included in the subscription costs for all club members.
- Future years will offer the option to renew the training kit as part of the subscription or purchase it separately through the Macron online shop.
- If parents or sponsors want to increase a person or teams training kit then they can do by visiting the online macron club shop and purchasing directly through them
- The Macron pack will be adopted for the 2025/26 season.
- Teams with existing training kits are encouraged to order the new Macron kit in a larger size for future use.

Rationale

This initiative aims to:

1. Create a more uniform and professional appearance for the club.
2. Meet the feedback received from committee members, managers, and coaches.
3. Align with the club's excellent facilities and match the professionalism of larger clubs like Dorking and Sutton.
4. Raise standards across the club for the upcoming season and beyond.



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Re-using kit

We will not be issuing any training kit with sponsorship. Taking this decision allows us to keep the training kit 'in the moment' with every kit looking the same throughout the club.

Re-using will support the kit being reused if in good condition by offering a swap shop throughout the season when the children outgrow garments. Any garment in a good condition can be offered for swap which will help all with reducing costs.

Conclusion

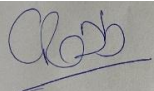
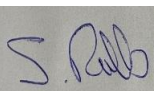
